Twinspired Racing for Second Stride, Inc.

Twinspired, racing in the 137th Kentucky Derby on May 7, 2011, has selected Second Stride, Inc. as his charity to receive a percentage of his purse winnings.

April 27, 2011 - PROSPECT, KY – Louisville-based partnership, Sky Chai Racing, Sand Dollar Stable, and Alpha Stable's Twinspired has chosen Second Stride, Inc. as the equine charity of choice to receive a portion of his future winnings. Twinspired lost by a nose in the Toyota Blue Grass Stakes (gr. I) on April 16 at Keeneland in Lexington, KY. The recent drop-out of horses on the Kentucky Derby graded earnings list moved Twinspired into the No. 20 spot with \$197,500.

Mike Smith, Hall of Fame jockey, will ride the gray, Kentucky-bred colt, Harlan's Holiday - Historical Drive, by El Prado. Mike Smith won the 2005 Kentucky Derby on 50-1 long shot, Giacomo.

We try to show the general equine community the extreme work ethics and trainability of these horses and the dedication and love the race trainers and owners have for them."
